## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE and CODE OF CONDUCT

The Easter Revision Course aims to provide a stimulating working environment for healthy examination preparation. To achieve this, and for the welfare and safety of all students and staff, these terms and conditions and code of conduct have been kept to an absolute minimum and must be strictly adhered to. Failure to abide by these rules may result in removal from the course and any refund of fees will be at the sole discretion of the Course Director.

- Full fees of the course must be paid in advance of tuition. Failure to adhere to this rule may result in the student being removed from the course.
- Parents or guardians will accept full liability for any damage to property caused by malice or neglect.
- Clifton College shall not be liable for loss or damage to personal property or injury to persons however caused, other than that where negligence on the part of Clifton College is proved. We recommend that all valuables are adequately covered by personal insurance.
- Any student behaving in a manner which might be considered detrimental to the smooth running of the course, or which might interfere with the studies of other students, may be removed from the course.
- Smoking is not permitted inside the College buildings or within the College campus.
- Drugs and alcohol must not be brought onto or consumed within the College campus. Failure to abide by this rule will result in immediate withdrawal from the course.
